2. COMPOSITION:

Short Straw is produced from premium Australian cereal crops and processed through mechanical chopping to provide a consistent, shortened fibre product. Common source materials include wheat straw, barley straw, and oaten straw.

The product is designed to provide a highly absorbent, easy-to-handle material suitable for animal bedding, livestock housing systems, and agricultural applications.

3. APPEARANCE:

Trade as sample, or low specs negotiated and agreed.

Typically presented as clean, chopped straw of uniform particle length with natural colour variation according to crop type and seasonal conditions.

4. SPECIFICATIONS:

Trade as sample, or specifications negotiated and agreed.

Typical quality parameters may include:
